Health & Family Welfare Department – Medical Education Service – Setting up of new Medical College at GH Campus, Thiruvananthapuram and Konni, Pathanamthitta -General Hospitals attached to Medical Colleges - Orders Issued.

ORDER

As per the Government Orders read as 1st and 2nd paper above, Government have issued administrative sanction to start new Medical Colleges at Konni in Pathanamthitta District and at G.H Campus, Thiruvananthapuram, respectively. Later, as per the G.O, read as 3rd paper above, Government have created faculty posts in the aforementioned two Medical Colleges. Now, Government are pleased to issue the following guidelines for the smooth functioning of the Government Medical Colleges at General Hospital Campus, Thiruvananthapuram and Government Medical College, Konni, Pathanamthitta.

(i) The General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram and the General Hospital, Pathanamthitta will henceforth be known as Government Medical College Hospital, GH Campus, Thiruvananthapuram and Government Medical College Hospital, Konni, Pathanamthitta, respectively.

(ii) All doctors from the Director of Health Services presently working in the General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram and General Hospital, Pathanamthitta will continue to work in the respective hospital under deemed deputation status. Those with Post Graduate Degree/ Diploma qualification will be re-designated as Assistant Professors and Senior Residents respectively. The Assistant Surgeons will be re-designated as Junior Residents. They will be given the option of non-practicing allowance as in the case of Government Medical College Hospitals.

(iii) The Principals and the Superintendents will work out composite units in all specialties, consisting of staff from the Medical College Hospitals and Director of Health Services stream so as to function as a Unit. However, doctors with more than 15 years service in the Health Services stream will function as a separate unit. Those doctors who are not willing to work under this composite unit are liable to be transferred out in view of the stipulations of the Medical Council of India.

(iv) The Director of Health Services will obtain the willingness for deputation from those doctors with PG Degree/PG Diploma working in the General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram and General Hospital, Pathanamthitta on working arrangement, to be deputed to Government Medical College Hospital, General Hospital Campus, Thiruvananthapuram and Government Medical College Hospital, Konni. The Director of Health Services will further obtain details from doctors having PG Degree having lien in Government Medical College Hospital, General Hospital

Campus, Thiruvananthapuram and Government Medical College Hospital, Konni are deputed to elsewhere and forward the same to Government for necessary action, posting them back to Thiruvananthapuram and Konni.

(v) All the staff posted from Medical Education Services and Health Services shall use all the assets of the hospitals including the diagnostic and tools equally without anyone have priority over the other. The Superintendent will lay down the guidelines on how to use these assets.

(vi) The present Superintendent of General Hospitals will be the Superintendent (Administration) and Director of Medical Education will post Superintendents with Post Graduate qualification as Superintendents (Medical). The Principals, will have the overall control of the respective hospitals for the purpose of running the Medical Colleges. The Superintendents (Administration) will be given an allowance of Rs.2000/- per month as applicable to the Deputy Superintendents of Government Medical Colleges in Medical Education Services.

vii) The Director of Medical Education will immediately post paramedical staff and pharmacists against the posts created within one week. The paramedical staff will work with other staff in the Colleges and shall be deployed by the Principals concerned and the Superintendent and accommodate the requirements of the Medical Council of India. The Director of Medical Education will furnish proposals for creating posts of Nurses and necessary staff as per requirements.

(viii) For the purpose of co-ordination, a Co- ordination Committee consisting of Principal, Superintendent (Medical), Superintendent (Administration) and one representative from each of the streams shall be formed in each College to lay down guidelines to sort out day to day operations and other services in the hospitals.

(ix) The Principals concerned will take urgent steps to post Senior Residents/Junior Residents/ Tutors and Demonstrators without any further delay.


